


## Surgical Safety Checklist (SSCL)

The surgical safety checklist (SSCL) is considered "performed" when the designated checklist coordinator confirms that surgical team members have implemented and/or addressed all of the necessary tasks and items in each of the three phases : Briefing;Time Out;and Debriefing.

This is a process measure, measuring the degree to which all three phases of the SSCLwas performed correctly and appropriately for each surgical patient.

## **Commentary:**

The surgical safety checklist - which covers the most common tasks and items that operating room teams carry out - has been shown to reduce rates of deaths and complications among patients .

This initiative requires commitment and teamwork within the operating room environment.

The compliance rate of 99.9% demonstrates successful implementation of this important patient safety initiative.
