The Disabled Discrimination Act (DDA)

The Disabled Discrimination Act (DDA) states that all user controls on parking equipment have to be located between 0.7 meters and 1.2 meters from ground level.



The **Varioflex** pay station is the only pay station on the market which fully achieves this stipulation without the need to have “cut-down” plinths or the like (which bring controls down for wheelchair users but make them extremely uncomfortable for able-bodied people). **Parkeon** achieved this by designing a motorized coin acceptor and a motorized, horizontal coin handing carousel. Other suppliers use gravity fed coin paths which require a coin slot high up on the machine and a vertical coin handing mechanism.
