The clinic's health care team includes nurses and nephrologists (physicians who specialize in the treatment of kidney disease) and incorporates best practices in chronic disease management, including prevention and self-management education. The clinic is also aligned with the Ontario Renal Network (ORN), the provincial government's advisor on renal care in Ontario. ORN provides overall leadership and strategic direction to organize and manage the delivery of dialysis and chronic kidney disease services in Ontario.

"We are thrilled to be able to offer this level of care to our community. The Regional Nephrology Clinic supports our strategic direction by focusing on the health care needs of a significant and growing portion of our patient population – those dealing with chronic disease," said Michelle DiEmanuele, President and CEO, Trillium Health Partners.
