Annual Report highlights key achievements from past year

MISSISSAUGA, ON (June 11, 2024) – It's been a landmark year for Trillium Health Partners (THP) as we marked major milestones on our bold vision of creating a new kind of health care for a healthier community. Released yesterday, THP's 2023-24 Annual Community Report showcases accomplishments from the past year and highlights our community's growing needs for <u>Trillium HealthWorks</u> – THP's major health infrastructure renewal plan that will build Canada's largest hospital, increase access to care, and bring specialized cutting-edge care closer to home.

In 2023-24, THP experienced more than 1.72 million patient visits and more than 8,500 births. THP also achieved the highest standing of quality care accreditation by Accreditation Canada with an exemplary score of 99.7% and was named one of Canada's Top 40 Research Hospitals for the second year in a row by Research Infosource Inc.

"Thank you to all the staff, nurses, physicians, learners, volunteers, donors, and community partners for your unwavering commitment to supporting the health of the community," said Christine Magee, Board Chair, THP. "Your dedication to inclusivity, innovation and exceptional patient experiences is helping to reimagine the future of health care for Mississauga and West Toronto."

THP marked new moments in its history with the completion and opening of Wellbrook Place, a new long-term care home with 632 beds operated by Partners Community Health, and breaking ground on the future home of The Gilgan Family Queensway Health Centre, which also features a new parking structure that opened earlier this year. THP also announced the future Shah Family Hospital for Women and Children, which will be a leading-edge facility and the first of its kind in Ontario dedicated to the unique health needs of women and children.

"What we have accomplished this past year is foundational work that is paving the way for a more connected and progressive health care system that is being co-designed and purpose-built with the unique needs of the diverse community in mind," said Karli Farrow, President and CEO of THP. "Our relentless focus on innovation, increased capacity and collaboration with community partners and providers will help to shape a healthier future for generations to come."

With artificial intelligence (AI) holding the potential to transform health care, THP has embraced AI to empower teams through a new partnership with Canadian health start-up, Signal 1, which can help to predict an acute patient's status over the next 72 hours. More AI advancements are underway for the coming year, as well as new innovations and technology that ensures specialized care is closer to home, including the minimally invasive cancer treatment procedure Y-90 that THP performed earlier this year.

THP's achievements would not be possible without the deep generosity of the more than 60,000 donors in the community who contributed an incredible \$112 million in gifts and commitments over the past year.

"The community's record-breaking contributions are not only an investment in the future of health care for our region, but an investment in the individuals and teams who work at THP," said
