Trillium Health Partners Launches \$25 Million Fundraising Initiative to Unlock AI for Better Health

Philanthropy-led momentum kick-starts with inaugural gift from philanthropist Suresh Madan to accelerate AI at the point of care

(MISSISSAUGA, ON – May 27, 2025) – Trillium Health Partners today announced a \$25 million fundraising initiative in support of its *AI for Better Health* program to accelerate the development of powerful new artificial intelligence (AI) tools to tackle some of health care's most challenging issues. AI and health analytics are key to transforming health care by creating a better patient and team experience, preventing and predicting diseases, easing pressure on hospitals and reducing costs and administrative burden.

"As one of Canada's busiest hospitals, we have no choice but to innovate," says Dr. Laura Rosella, Chief Scientist and Stephen Family Research Chair in Community Health at the Institute for Better Health, Trillium Health Partners' research and innovation engine. "Serving one of the country's most diverse and fastest-growing populations, the advanced analytics and Al tools we develop, test and scale here will shape the future of health care in Canada and beyond. With the courage to challenge what no longer works, we are charting a course that will establish our community as a global beacon for better health."

Trillium Health Partners' *AI for Better Health* program will focus on strengthening our health system, supporting clinicians, researchers and patient care leaders to apply AI safely and effectively. It will drive responsive, ethical and rapidly evolving approaches to advanced analytics and AI that address real-world health care challenges.

Trillium Health Partners and its Institute for Better Health are already developing, testing and scaling Al solutions: from photo-based tools that assess nutrition in long-term care, to machine models that inform diabetes prevention and management, to predictive models that streamline hospital discharges. A recent pilot using Al for discharge planning reduced discharge times by an average of 12 hours, easing pressure on the hospital and improving the experience for both patients and the care team.

"At Trillium Health Partners, we believe health care should be designed around people, not places," said Dr. Sam Sabbah, Chief of Staff. "With Al and digital innovation, hospitals will serve as specialized hubs in a connected, human-centred system of care that follows the person. Everyone deserves access to care in the environment that best supports their dignity and healing. Al will play a critical role in bringing this vision to life — shifting health care from treating illness to predicting and preventing it, and ensuring care is timely, accessible, and closer to home."



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Kickstarting this vision is the inaugural philanthropic gift from Suresh Madan and his wife, Sarita, who have established the Sarita and Suresh Madan Al Acceleration Fund. This fund will support clinicians, researchers, and team members in developing and deploying cutting-edge Al solutions to create better health, marking the first step toward the \$25 million fundraising goal for *Al for Better Health*.

"Al can be game-changing in health care. It has the potential to improve diagnosis, reduce medical errors, enhance the efficiency of our health systems, and more," says Suresh Madan, entrepreneur and Trillium Health Partners Foundation Board Member. "We hope this fund inspires researchers and practitioners to harness that potential and deliver better health care for everyone."

Al for Better Health is a fundamental leap toward a new kind of health care that's deeply rooted in real-world impact to create a healthier future for everyone.
