

All Women's and Children's Inpatient Services Now Integrated at Credit Valley Hospital

Trillium Health Partners marks major milestone toward the future Shah Family Hospital for Women and Children

October 8, 2025 (Mississauga, Ontario) – Today marks an important milestone for Trillium Health Partners and the future Shah Family Hospital for Women and Children as all women's and children's inpatient services have officially moved to the Credit Valley Hospital. This integration brings birthing, neonatal intensive care, gynecology, and paediatric inpatient services together under one roof, creating a single, coordinated hub of care for women, children, and families.

"For our patients, families, and care teams, this is an important step forward in strengthening care for women and children in our region and beyond," said Karli Farrow, President and CEO of Trillium Health Partners. "By bringing services together at Credit Valley Hospital, we're making care easier to navigate, supporting our teams to work even more closely, and creating the foundation for the future Shah Family Hospital for Women and Children."

The integration ensures a seamless, patient-centered experience and enhances the ability of Trillium Health Partners' teams to provide expert, specialized care.

Highlights of the integration for patients and families:

- All inpatient women's and children's services are now in one location, making it easier for families to navigate care and for teams to deliver it efficiently.
- High-impact programs such as the Paediatric Sickle Cell Clinic (in partnership with SickKids), the Perinatal Community Care Program, and Maternal-Fetal Medicine services for high-risk pregnancies are now centralized, improving access today and enabling future program growth and innovation.
- Renovated spaces allow birthing parents and babies cared for in the NICU to stay together, supporting family-centered care.
- Bringing teams together fosters collaboration, innovation, and talent development while supporting future research, teaching, and partnerships.

"Our teams are passionate about caring for women, children, and families," said 'Remi Ejiwunmi, Vice President, Shah Family Hospital for Women and Children. "Working side by side at Credit Valley Hospital allows us to share expertise more easily, support families with care that feels seamless and close to home and build the foundation for the future Shah Family Hospital for Women and Children."

Emergency care will continue at both the Mississauga Hospital and the Credit Valley Hospital. If patients arrive at the Mississauga Hospital's Emergency Department and require specialized care from an obstetrician/gynecologist or paediatrician located at the Credit Valley Hospital, our teams will ensure a safe and timely transfer. This approach ensures that all patients receive the right care, from the right specialists, at the right time.
